**Unit I: The Prophets Proclaim GOD'S Power:**

**Subject: All for one and One for All**

**Text: Ezekiel 37: 21-28**

**Key Verse:**

**My tabernacle also shall be with them: yea, I will be their GOD, and hey shall be my people (Ezekiel 37: 27, KJV).**

**Introduction**

**Have you ever been on a team when you had been counted out, and not having a chance to win it all. But because of the teams unity and willingness to work together, things changed, and you and the team found themselves in the championship game when no one gave you a chance. Well as believers in JESUS CHRIST, we are often counted out because of our faith in JESUS CHRIST; but because of our steadfast faith in JESUS CHRIST, we become victorious and prosperous in life when others have counted us out. We surrender completely to our LORD and Savior and willingly follow HIM (JESUS CHRIST), understanding that it is All for One and One for All.**

**Lesson Pointer # 1**

- Unity Redeemed (Ezekiel 37: 21-24)**

**Ezekiel's prophetic proclamation of the restoration of GOD's people as one nation led by one King. The LORD tells Ezekiel to speak, stating that the LORD shall bring the children of Israel from among the heathen, and from wherever they may be scattered, and bring them into their own land (Ezekiel 37: 21). Now, the LORD will restore them upon HIS holy hill and rise up a leader, king, who shall rule the divided people as one nation. And that they will no longer be two nations but shall become one (Ezekiel 37: 22). They will no longer defile themselves with idols, nor with any detestable things, nor with their transgressions: but the LORD shall save them out of all their dwelling places, wherein they have sinned, and the LORD will cleanse them: so shall they be the LORD'S people, and the LORD will be their GOD (Ezekiel 37: 23). And David the LORD'S servant shall be king over them; and they shall have one shepherd, and walk in the LORD'S judgments, and observe the LORD'S statutes, and do them (Ezekiel 37: 24). Now, with confidence and obedience the people will know they have been redeemed by the LORD.**

## **Lesson Pointer # 2**

**Unity Displayed (Ezekiel 37: 25-28).**

**And the people shall dwell in the land that the LORD have given unto Jacob HIS servant, they and their children, and their children's children for ever: and the LORD's servant David shall be their prince for ever (Ezekiel 37: 25). The LORD will make an everlasting covenant of peace with HIS people, and the LORD will place them, and multiply them, and set HIS sanctuary in the midst of them for evermore (Ezekiel 37: 26). The LORD'S tabernacle shall also be with them: yes, the LORD will be their GOD, and they shall be the LORD'S people (Ezekiel 37: 27). And the heathen will know that the LORD do sanctify Israel, when the LORD'S sanctuary shall be in the midst of them for evermore (Ezekiel 37: 28). The unity displayed is GOD, letting the world know that HE (JESUS CHRIST) is good and gracious toward HIS people.**
