**Unit III:** God's Eternal Reign

**Subject:** Total Power!

**Text:** 1 Corinthians 15: 20-28

**Key Verse:**

When all things shall be subdued unto him, then shall the Son also himself be subject unto him that put all things under him, that GOD may be all in all (1 Corinthians 15: 28, KJV).

**Introduction:**

Atheists, skeptics, and even some believers doubt GOD'S Omnipotence, they believe that GOD is not all powerful, but do know, that one day every knee shall bow, and every tongue shall confess to GOD (Romans 14: 11). Now, concerning the doubters, **Romans 3: 3-4** says, "For what if some did not believe? Shall their unbelief make the faith of GOD without effect? 4 GOD forbid: yea, let GOD be true, but every man a liar; as it is written, That thou mightiest be justified in thy sayings, and mightiest overcome when thou art judged." So, it is good to know that human unbelief has no power to diminish the truth that GOD; the Creator of the universe and sustainer of all things, has all power, is absolute Omnipotence in heaven and on earth.

**Lesson pointer # 1**

- Victory over Sin (1 Corinthians 15: 20-22)

GOD the Father raised up HIS Son JESUS CHRIST from the dead is good news. The resurrection is the good news for believers because it is both the evidence of GOD'S grace to humanity and to what lies ahead of the eternal life in glory with GOD the Father; and JESUS CHRIST become the firstfruits of them that slept (1 Corinthians 15: 20). Now, as the "firstfruits" JESUS CHRIST represents the initial offering or payment, guaranteeing the resurrection of the righteous. Because Adam's sin condemned humanity to inherit eternal death, which is separation from GOD. But because of the second Adam (JESUS CHRIST, our Savior), every believer shall be resurrected from their mortal bodies by GOD the Father's redemptive purpose that gives victory over sin of unbelief, and gives eternal access to the presence of GOD the Father (1 Corinthians 15: 21). Because of one man, Adam, disobedience, we were all bound to an eternal death; but through JESUS CHRIST, we all victory and access to eternal life (1 Corinthians 15: 22).

**Lesson Pointer # 2**

- **Victory over Satan (1 Corinthians 15: 23-25)**

**JESUS CHRIST HIMSELF, the first to conquer the grave; and the faithful in JESUS CHRIST at HIS coming; and all of the rest of humanity at the final judgment (1 Corinthians 15: 23). At the end, all evil shall be stamped out and forever defeated upon the face of the earth, and the Kingdom of GOD shall be restored (1 Corinthians 15: 24). The final victory over Satan and his emps shall reveal JESUS CHRIST'S ultimate power, and HIS reign and rule will be final and complete (1 Corinthians 15: 25). The enemy (Satan) shall be defeated, and the saints shall worship the LORD JESUS CHRIST for HIS mighty acts. John the Baptist upon seeing JESUS CHRIST coming unto him, said, "Behold the Lamb of GOD, which taketh away the sin of the world." Victory over Satan.**
